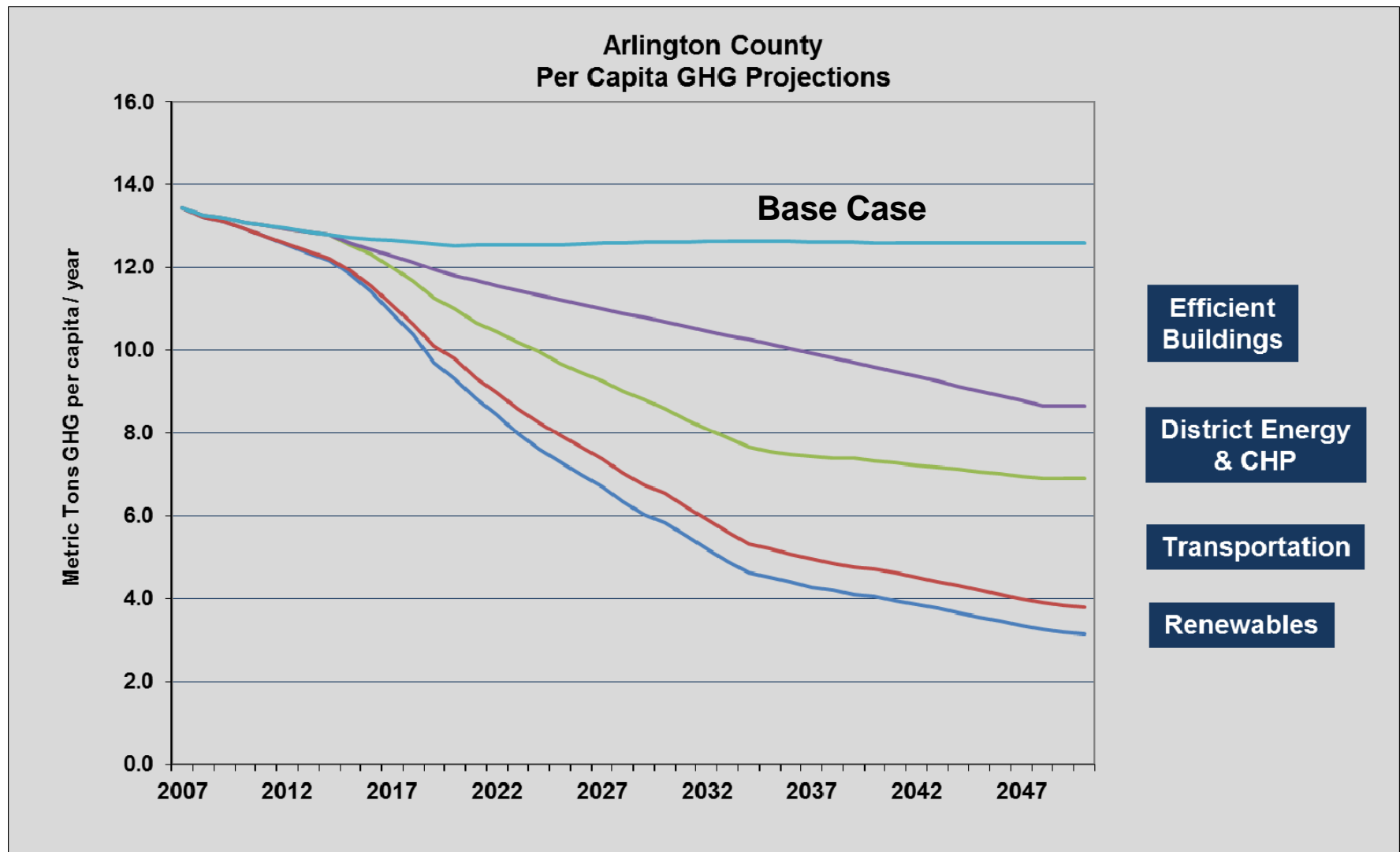


Community Energy Project: Background

2050 Goal: 3 metric tons per capita



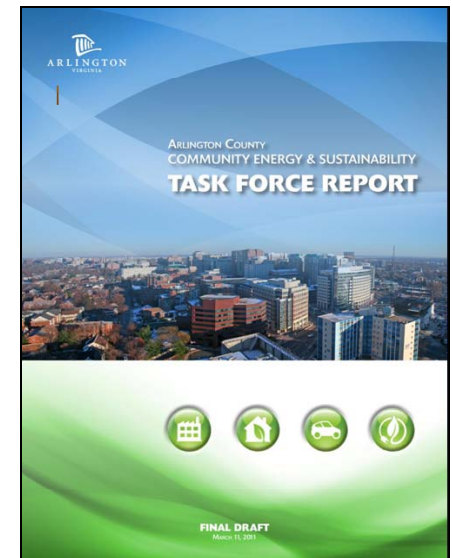
County Board Adopted Policy Direction

- Increase energy supply and distribution efficiency in Arlington using district energy, renewable energy and other tools

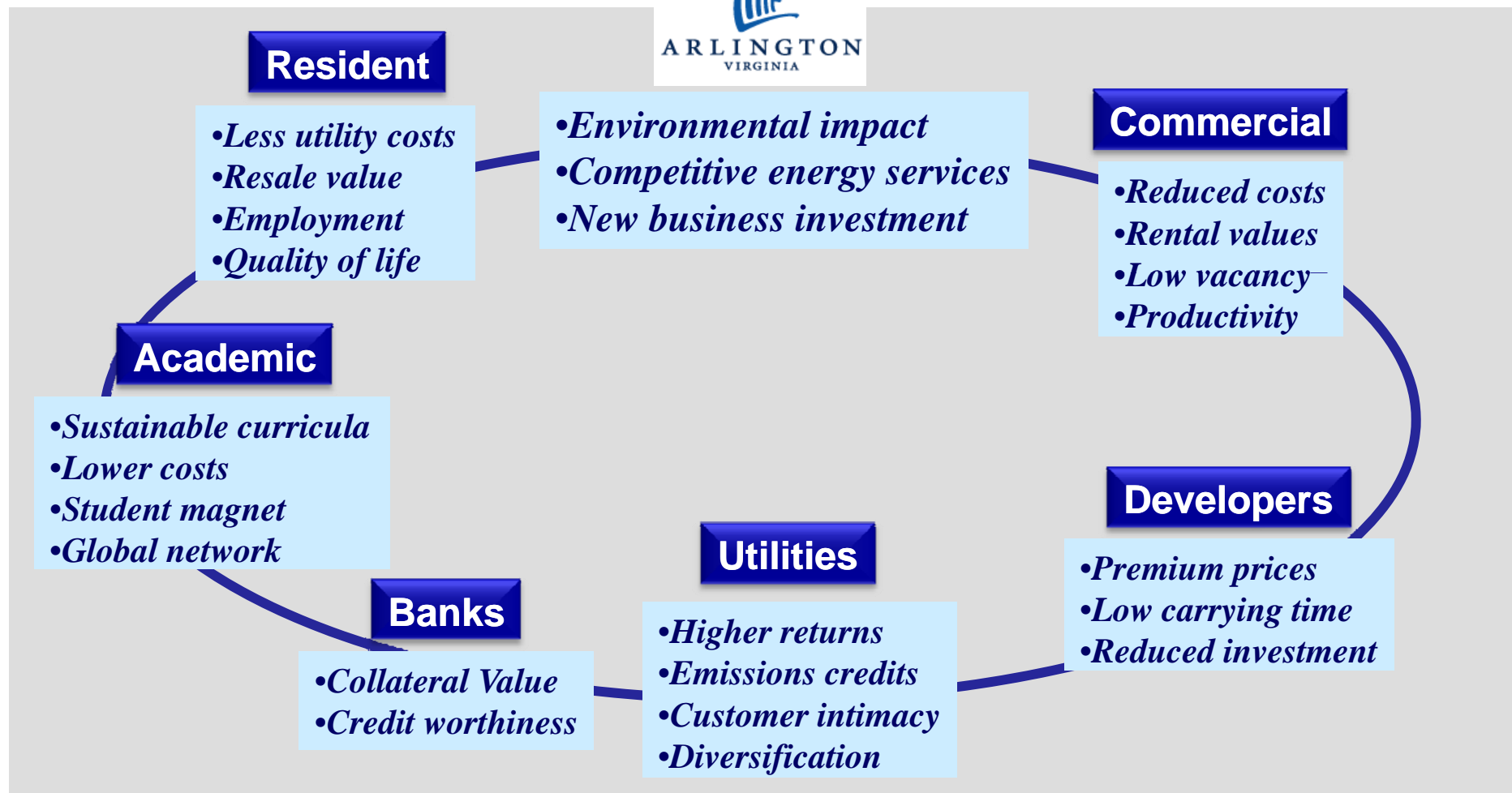


County Board Adopted Policy Direction
